

Types of Adaptations

- camouflage - blending in to its environment by coloring of body
- mimicry - copying another organism's looks or behavior
- structural - parts of the organism
 - claws/talons (to help dig or catch prey)
 - teeth shape → based on what they eat
 - beak shape
 - wings
 - hooves (protect feet on hard ground)
 - webbed feet (swimming)
 - fur type (thick/thin) or feathers
 - spines/thorns (protection)
- migration - movement of animal group to better environmental conditions
- hibernation - "sleeping" through the cold, winter months.
