	<p>A group of students walk into the lab and notice lab equipment on their table. Two students pick up the equipment and start talking about it with each other.</p>
	<p>A group of students are using a hot plate to boil water. A student with long hair leans over the hot plate. Her hair is touching the hot plate. Another student touches the hot coils.</p>
	<p>A group of students are using regular soda, diet soda, vinegar, and water to conduct a science investigation. One student takes a sip of the regular soda while no one is watching.</p>
	<p>A group of students are working with oil and water. One student accidentally knocks over the glass beaker with oil in it. Another student gets a paper towel and wipes up the spill and throws the broken glass in the trashcan.</p>
	<p>A group of students are working with magnets and iron filings. They start the activity by wearing goggles. One student moves his goggles to the top of his head to rub his eyes.</p>
	<p>A group of students are using owl pellets to conduct a lab investigation. One student takes his glove off to examine the pieces of the pellet more closely. After the lab they clean their station and leave the classroom.</p>
